- 1. Critically comment on Aristotle's exploration of the idea of 'mimesis' in *Poetics*.
- 2. Illustrate, with reference to the text, how Horace in his *Art of Poetry* argues that the function of great poetry is to teach and delight.
- **3.** Attempt a critical review of Longinus's views on true and false 'sublime' in his *On the Sublime*.
- 4. Discuss some of the principal arguments of Sidney in *The Defence of Poesie*.
- 5. Show how, through its dialogic nature, John Dryden's *Essay of Dramatic Poesy* attempts a critique of the classical ideas of poetry.
- 6. Show how Dr Johnson in his 'Preface to Shakespeare' establishes that Shakespeare's plays are not only meant for the stage, but are also texts to be read critically.
