- 1. With reference to the concept of 'death of the author', explain how the traditional notion of authorship is questioned and subverted in *The French Lieutenant's Woman*.
- 2. Would you agree with view that the crises in *Six Characters in Search of an Author* develop from an understanding of social taboos? Elaborate your answer by explaining what role the medium of theatre plays in addressing such crises.
- 3. The dominant theme of Beckett's *Endgame* is stated in the opening sentence of Clov's prologue: 'Finished, it's finished, nearly finished, it must be nearly finished.' Critically analyse this view.
- 4. Show how the human and the non-human coalesce in the theatre space that Ionesco creates. Discuss with special reference to *Rhinoceros*.
- 5. How does Marquez use both linear and circular time in *One Hundred Years of Solitude*? Answer with suitable textual references.
- 6. Consider Calvino's use of 'interruptions' in the narrative of *If on a Winter's Night a Traveller*.
