- c) Write briefly on the function of Medley in *The Man of Mode*.

- b) Comment on the seeming contradictions with reference to different theories of history as enumerated in *Gulliver's Travels*.
- c) Why does Tristram say that Uncle Toby's amours are 'the choicest morsel of my story'? Give reasons for your answer.
- 4. Answer any one of the following questions:

- a) Comment on Evelina's statement in the final letter 'All is over, my dearest Sir...'.
- b) Why do you think Gulliver struggles to avoid the appellation "Yahoo" in Book IV of *Gulliver's Travels*?
- c) Discuss in brief Sterne's drawing of the straight line in Volume VI chapter XL of *Tristram Shandy*.
